## RESIGNATION OF MR. NICK FADUGBA AS SECRETARY GENERAL OF AFRAA

The African Airlines Association (AFRAA) wishes to announce that the Secretary General, Mr. Nick Fadugba has resigned from the employment of AFRAA. According to Mr. Fadugba's letter of resignation, he is leaving AFRAA to focus on his private business from where he states he could serve the aviation industry better. Mr. Fadugba was elected during the 41<sup>st</sup> AFRAA Annual General Assembly meeting in Maputo, Mozambique in November 2009 and he assumed duty on 18 February 2010.

Mr. Fadugba has stated in his widely circulated press statement, that he "looks forward to continuing the longstanding close relationship between AFRAA, African Aviation Services (AAS) and African Aviation Magazine in promoting aviation development in Africa, a goal which unites all of us".

In the interim, the day-to-day activities of the Association will be managed by an Interim Secretariat Management Committee made up of the Directors under the close supervision of the Chairman of the Executive Committee.
